### CANDIDATE CRITERIA

*The Center for Leadership seeks diverse candidates from private, public, and non-profit sectors.*

- **Professional Achievement:** Those in leadership positions or poised to take such a role in their organization in the near-term.
- **Education:** Undergraduate degree or higher.
- **Work Experience:** Minimum of five years of experience in the real estate industry or related field.
- **Commitment:** This program requires a significant time commitment. It is a six-month program with six full-day seminars and a team project. If accepted to this prestigious and competitive leadership program, you pledge in good faith to be fully-engaged and involved. **Attendance at both the overnight retreat (Bainbridge Island) on January 31 - February 1 and the last program day is mandatory. Only one excused absence during the other session months is permitted.**

### PLEASE NOTE

- Reliable transportation is required as program sessions will take place throughout the Puget Sound region. Most sessions can be reached by taking public transit or sharing a ride.
- There might be homework and other team project work that must be done outside of dedicated class time.
- ULI membership or sponsorship is not a requirement for this program, however ULI members and sponsors receive priority application review and discounted tuition.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- **Resume, a personal biography (500 words maximum), and cover letter that includes current work responsibilities and community involvement.**
- **Essay Questions (One page per question):**
  1. What do you think is the greatest land use/development challenge facing the Puget Sound region today? What approach would you take to address this issue in the next ten years?
  2. What are your professional development goals? How do you anticipate the Center for Leadership program will improve your leadership or performance abilities?

### CENTER FOR LEADERSHIP APPLICATION TIMELINE

- Complete applications must be submitted by **Monday, November 5, 2018**
- Those selected for the program will be notified by **Friday, November 16, 2018**
- Participants must confirm acceptance in the Center for Leadership program via email by **Friday, November 30, 2018**
- Full tuition must be received by **Friday, December 14, 2018.**
- Tuition is \$3000 (private sector) and \$2200 (non-profit/public sector) (ULI Private Sector Members receive a \$440 discount/ULI Public Sector Members receive a \$220 discount). ULI Northwest Annual Sponsors receive up to \$800 off individual tuition. A limited number of need-based scholarships are available; please contact [northwest@uli.org](mailto:northwest@uli.org) for more information.
- Tuition includes complimentary admission to all general ULI Northwest events from January to June 2019, an approximate \$500 value.
